## Introduced by Senator Jinggoy Ejercito Estrada

## AN ACT

TO AMEND CERTAIN SECTIONS OF REPUBLIC ACT SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE (R.A. 7431) OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY ACT OF 1992," AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

Section 1. RA 7431 entitled, "An Act Regulating the Practice of Radiologic Technology in the Philippines, Creating the Board of Radiologic Technology Defining its Powers and Functions and for Other Purposes," Section 3 Paragraphs (f) and (g) of are hereby deleted and paragraphs (h) and (i) of the same section are correspondingly renumbered as (f) and (g). In addition, a new paragraph (h) shall be included. Amendments are as follows:

"(H) "AIPO" REFERS TO THE ACCREDITED AND 9 10 **INTEGRATED PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION OF X-**11 RAY TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC 12 TECHNOLOGISTS THAT THE BOARD HAS ACCREDITED, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL BY THE 13 14 COMMISSION, AS THE ONE AND ONLY ACCREDITED INTEGRATED NATIONAL ORGANIZATION OF X-RAY 15 16 TECHNOLOGISTS AND RADIOLOGIC 17 **TECHNOLOGISTS."**

Penal Provisions. - Any person who shall 9 practice X-RAY TECHNOLOGY OR RADIOLOGIC 10 **TECHNOLOGY** in the Philippines, within the meaning of this Act, with any of the following attending circumstances shall, 11 12 upon conviction by final judgment, be punished with a fine of 13 not less than Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) nor more 14 than Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00) or by imprisonment 15 of not less than one (1) year nor more than six (6) years or 16 both, at the discretion of the court:

18 Sec. 12. *Separability Clause.* – If any provision of this Act is declared 19 unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of this Act or any provisions not affected 20 thereby shall remain in force and effect.

Sec. 13. *Repealing Clause.* – Any law, presidential decrees or issuance, executive orders, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule, or regulation contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

Sec. 14. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date
 of its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
