## RESOLUTION

## CONGRATULATING THE PHILIPPINES' YOUNGEST JIU-JITSU CHAMPION, ALEIA AIELLE AGUILAR FOR WINNING IN THE 2022 WORLD YOUTH JIU-JITSU CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD IN ABU DHABI, UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

1	WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, give recognition
2	and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their exceptional feats of bringing
3	honor, pride and glory to the country by garnering prestigious awards;

5	WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution states that "The State shall promote physical
6	education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports,
7	including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork,
8	and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

10	WHEREAS, The World Youth Jiu-Jitsu Championships are organized to prepare
11	jiu-jitsu athletes across all categories and spread the culture of jiu-jitsu amongst
12	community in order to advance the sport locally, regionally and globally;

14	WHEREAS, Aleia Aielle Aguilar won against Gabriela Vercosa of Brazil in the
15	final round to capture the gold in the kids' 1 under-16-Kilogram event of the 2022 Abu
16	Dhabi World Youth Jiu-Jitsu Championships at the Jiu-jitsu Arena in Abu Dhabi;

18	WHEREAS, Aleia, is the five-year-old daughter of one of the country's mixed
19	martial arts pillars, Alvin Aguilar, and first ever Filipino Jiu-jitsu World Champion,

Maybelline Masuda. She became the Philippines' youngest world youth champion in
jiu-jitsu;
