RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND RECOGNIZING NATIONAL YOUTH CHESS TEAM FOR BEING THE OVERALL CHAMPION IN THE 6th EASTERN ASIA YOUTH CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP HELD IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

WHEREAS, Elle Castronuevo (Cavite) has clinched victory in the U8 Girls category;

WHEREAS, Mary Janelle Tan (Cagayan de Oro City), Deandra Castronuevo (Cavite), Glasses Ann Hilario (Bulacan), Nika Juris Nicolas (Pasig City) and Cyreine Jean Borce (Zamboanga City) have won in the U10 Girls category;

WHEREAS, Jemaicah Yap Mendoza (Romblon) and Ashzley Aya Nicole Paquinol (Cagayan de Oro City) have competed in the U12 Girls category;

WHEREAS, Richily Evans Cuizon (Cagayan de Oro City), Daren Dela Cruz (Cavite), Ruelle Canino (Cagayan de Oro City), Rylen Bahita (Negros Oriental) and Kaye Lalaine Regidor (Laguna) have excelled in the U14 Girls category;

WHEREAS, Lexie Grace Hernandez (Pampanga) and Angella Joelle San Luis (Zamboanga City) have bagged medals in the U18 Girls category;

WHEREAS, Caleb Royce Garcia (Quezon City), Jury Joaquin Ferrer (Cagayan), Seigneur Juancho Ferrer (Cagayan), and Seth David Juico (Zamboanga del Norte) have hauled medals in the U8 Open category;

WHEREAS, Shan Lester Jamerlan (Iloilo), John Curt Valencia (Cavite) and Bince Rafael Operania (Albay) have excelled in the U10 Open category;

WHEREAS, David Sean Romualdez (Pasig City), Oshrie Jhames Reyes (Pampanga), Al-Basher Buto (Rizal) and Sebastian Marbas (Cagayan de Oro City) have won medals in the U12 Open category;

WHEREAS, John Cyrus Borce (Zamboanga City), Christian Gian Karlo Arca (Cavite) and Ivan Travis Cu (San Juan City) have dominated the U14 Open category;
