ANACT

DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MARIANO AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALANAN, PROVINCE OF ISABELA, AS ECOTOURISM ZONES, TO BE JOINTLY KNOWN AS THE SAN MARIANO-PALANAN ECOTOURISM CORRIDOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The Municipality of San Mariano and the Municipality of Palanan in the
- 2 Province of Isabela are hereby declared as ecotourism zones, to be jointly known as the San
- 3 Mariano-Palanan Ecotourism Corridor. Pursuant thereto, the development of the San Mariano-
- 4 Palanan Ecotourism Corridor shall be prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism
- 5 (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of ecotourism zones.
- 6 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the municipal governments
- 7 of San Mariano and Palanan shall, in coordination with the DOT, Department of Environment
- 8 and Natural Resources (DENR), Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH),
- 9 Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) and concerned agencies of the
- government, prepare a comprehensive tourism development plan for the San Mariano-Palanan

- 1 Ecotourism Corridor. The development plan shall include the identification, validation,
- 2 construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate facilities and infrastructure to
- 3 enhance ecotourism in the areas: Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the
- 4 preservation of the cultural heritage of the areas and the conservation of its biophysical assets,
- 5 and incorporate strategies and programs to promote sustainable economic opportunities for the
- 6 local communities: Provided, further, That the implementation of the tourism development
- 7 plan shall be included in the respective budgets of the municipal governments of San Mariano
- 8 and Palanan.
- 9 The municipal governments of San Mariano and Palanan, DOT, DPWH and TIEZA
- shall prioritize the construction and completion of the San Mariano-Palanan Road in order to
- ensure the accessibility of tourists.
- SEC. 3. The DOT shall assist the municipal governments of San Mariano and Palanan
- in the implementation of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in
- 14 tourism capacity building. It shall also include the San Mariano-Palanan Ecotourism Corridor
- in its national and regional promotion programs.
- SEC. 4. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the
- 17 respective annual budgets of the municipal governments of San Mariano and Palanan. The
- 18 DOT may augment such allocation with internally-generated funds.
- 19 SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the municipal
- 20 governments of San Mariano and Palanan shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned
- 21 agencies of the government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.
- SEC. 6. If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the
- other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
- SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, executive orders, proclamations, presidential
- 25 decrees and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby
- 26 deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

- 1 SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
- 2 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
