## RESOLUTION EXPRESSING PROFOUND SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES ON THE DEATH OF SYLVIA REYES LA TORREDE TAGLE

She was also a star in movies such as "Ang Maestra" and "One Two Bato, Three Four Bapor." She also hosted popular shows such as "Oras ng Ligaya";

WHEREAS, in 2017, Sylvia was given the Excellence in Music award by the
Filipino American Symphony Orchestra for her immense contribution to Philippine folk
and popular music. She has also been a strong candidate for the National Artist award;

WHEREAS, the craftsmanship she showed in her illustrious career contributed immensely to the development of the Philippine entertainment industry. She has truly left a legacy in music and entertainment that will serve as inspiration and guiding light for the younger generation of artists and creative workers;

WHEREAS, the passing away of the seasoned and multi-awarded singer and actress is a great loss, not only to her family, but to the entire nation as well;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate, to express profound sympathy and sincere condolences of the Senate of the Philippines on the death of Sylvia Reyes La Torre-De Tagle.
