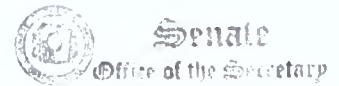

RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND RECOGNIZING THE NATIONAL JUNIOR GYMNASTS FOR THEIR IMPRESSIVE MEDAL HAUL IN THE 2022 JRC ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS STARS CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD LAST NOVEMBER 17 - 20, 2022 IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, give recognition and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their exceptional feats of bringing honor, pride and glory to the country by garnering prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution states that "The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

WHEREAS, the 2022 JRC Artistic Gymnastics Stars Championships is a five-nation tournament hosted by the Gymnastics Association of Thailand, and participated by 26 clubs from Hong Kong, Vietnam, India and host Thailand, and the Philippines;

WHEREAS, The National Junior Gymnasts for winning nine (9) gold, nine (9) silver, and eight (8) bronze medals at the recently concluded 2022 JRC Artistic Gymnastics Stars Championships held in Bangkok, Thailand;

WHEREAS, Elaiza "Iza" Andriel Ysar Yulo, 13 years old, bagged four (4) gold medals in vault, uneven bars, floor exercise and individual all-around;

WHEREAS, Karl Jahrel Eldrew Yulo, 14 years old, hauled six medals – a gold in floor exercise, silver medals in individual all-around, parallel bars, vault and pommel horse and a bronze medal in rings;

WHEREAS, In level four - men's competition, Justine Capellan showed his skills by winning two silver medals in the pommel horse and vault plus a bronze medal in the horizontal bar;

1 **WHEREAS**, Marc Nathan Ayson also sparkled in the same competition level,
2 winding up with silver medal in the still rings and bronze medal in the pommel horse;

3 **WHEREAS**, Marcus Labrador reaped gold and bronze medals in various
4 categories of the gymnastics events, including three gold medal feats in the pommel,
5 vault, and parallel bar from level two competition of men’s artistic gymnastics;

6 **WHEREAS**, In level two women’s competition, Marina Amelia Teves ruled the
7 balance beam with silver medal;

8 **WHEREAS**, Sophia Marie Estaban hauled silver medals in the vault and balance
9 beam;

10 **WHEREAS**, Allison Chiong won bronze medal in the floor exercises;

11 **WHEREAS**, Minka Elise Mathay clinched bronze medal in the uneven bars;

12 **WHEREAS**, the outstanding performance of Filipino Junior Gymnasts in the
13 2022 JRC Artistic Gymnastics Stars Championships deserves commendation for
14 bringing pride and honor to our nation for their strength, flexibility, balance and
15 control. They have served as inspiration to their fellow aspiring athletes for their
16 dedication at a young age;

17 **WHEREAS**, the impressive medal haul of the national junior gymnasts in their
18 international competition have shown a deep pool of promising talents and future of
19 the Philippine gymnastics;

20 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to
21 congratulate and recognize the National Junior Gymnasts for their impressive
22 achievement in the 2022 JRC Artistic Gymnastics Stars Championships held on
23 November 17 - 20, 2022 in Bangkok, Thailand.
