

RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING MAY PARSONS, THE NURSE WHO ADMINISTERED THE WORLD'S FIRST COVID-19 VACCINE AND RECIPIENT OF THE PRESTIGIOUS GEORGE CROSS AWARD, FOR REAFFIRMING THE PIVOTAL ROLE OF FILIPINO NURSES IN THE GLOBAL HEALTHCARE SCENE

WHEREAS, the Covid-19 pandemic highlighted the deficiencies in the Philippine healthcare sector, but also reaffirmed the gallantry, selflessness, hard work and dedication of Filipino healthcare workers, not only in the country but around the world;

WHEREAS, the rapid development of a vaccine against Covid-19 is truly a historic scientific achievement and its first administration by a Filipina nurse based in the United Kingdom is an honor to the country and to all Filipino nurses around the world;

WHEREAS, May Parsons made history as the first person in the world to deliver the first clinically-approved Covid-19 vaccination to a patient at the University Hospital in Coventry, England on 08 December 2020 marking the deployment of the vaccine globally¹;

WHEREAS, her momentous role earned her the George Cross Award from the late Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Charles of England on 12 July 2020, which she received in behalf of the United Kingdom's National Health Service (NHS) to which she has been affiliated. The George Cross Award is the highest civil award given to honor exceptional courage and heroism by non-military groups or individuals²;

WHEREAS, Parsons is a nursing graduate of the University of Santo Tomas
(UST) in 2000 who, after three years of working at the UST hospital, left for the United
Kingdom to join the NHS. She has since been with the University Hospitals Coventry
and Warwickshire and is presently a Modern Matron for Respiratory Services ³ ;

WHEREAS, Nurse Parsons recently completed her MSc Global Healthcare Management at Coventry University as part of the first cohort on the Senior Leaders Master's Degree Apprenticeship⁴;

WHEREAS, at her graduation, she was bestowed with the Endeavour Award, given to students who demonstrated skills and attributes that go "above and beyond" throughout the course of their studies⁵;

WHEREAS, Parson's historic role in this pandemic and the recognitions she received thereafter echo the important role of Filipino nurses in the global healthcare scene;

WHEREAS, Parson is truly an inspiration to the entire nursing profession for her commitment to saving lives, best patient care, and overall better and healthier futures for the communities she serves;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate of the Philippines, to recognize and commend May Parsons, the nurse who administered the world's first Covid-19 vaccine and recipient of the prestigious George Cross award, for reaffirming the pivotal role of Filipino nurses in the global healthcare scene.
