AN ACT

PROMOTING COMMUNITY-BASED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES THROUGH HIRING OF AT LEAST ONE PSYCHOLOGIST PER CITY OR MUNICIPALITY, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Mental health issues have been an increasing concern not only in the Philippines but in the entire world. In a 2019 World Health Organization study, it was found out that 1 in every 8 people, or 970 million people around the world are living with mental health problems, with anxiety and depression the most common. These mental health problems are taking its toll in the lives of the youth and adults alike.

These problems remain unaddressed due to a gap between the people needing the care and access thereto. In order to address this developing concern, there is a need to bridge the gap between the community and the mental health care providers.

This bill seeks to raise mental health awareness to increase understanding and reduce stigma, and make access to quality mental health care and effective treatments closer to the community. It aims to reduce mental health cases by hiring a psychologist per city or municipality who will be available for consultation and provide counseling to persons experiencing various mental health conditions.

In view of the foregoing, immediate approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- Section 1. *Short Title*. This Act shall be known as the "*Sikolohista Para sa Bayan*Act of 2022"
- Sec. 2. *Declaration of Policy.* It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote mental health awareness and provide comprehensive, integrated and responsive mental health and social care services in community-based settings.
 - The State recognizes the important role that mental health plays in achieving global development goals. Hence, an increased investment in all fronts and efforts to increase access to quality mental health care and effective treatments shall be a priority measure for the government.
- Sec. 3. *Hiring of One (1) Psychologist per City/Municipality* The Local Government Units shall hire at least one (1) psychologist per city/municipality who will be available for consultation and will provide counselling to persons experiencing various mental health conditions.

- Sec. 5. *Implementing Rules*. Within ninety days from the effectivity of this Act, the Civil Service Commission (CSC), in coordination with the Department of Health shall promulgate the guidelines for this Act.
- Sec. 6. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- Sec. 7. *Repealing Clause.* All laws, decrees, executive orders, letters of instructions, proclamations, rules and regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act shall be deemed notified, amended, or repealed accordingly.
- Sec. 8. *Effectivity Clause.* This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the *Official Gazette* or a newspaper of general circulation.
