RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE ASIAN MATHSCI LEAGUE, INC. (AMSLI) — PHILIPPINES FOR THEIR SUCCESSFUL CAMPAIGN IN THE INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR MATH OLYMPIAD AND THE VANDA SCIENCE GLOBAL FINALS HELD IN SINGAPORE
