RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON TOURISM TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORTED PLANS OF THE BUREAU OF CORRECTIONS TO BUILD A NEW HEADQUARTERS AT THE MASUNGI GEORESERVE

WHEREAS, Ecotourism and Conservation site Masungi Georeserve raised an alarm over an area inspection conducted by Bureau of Corrections (BuCor) personnel, for the alleged relocation site of the New Bilibid Prison within the geopark's vicinity¹;

WHEREAS, according to news reports, acting BuCor Director General, Gregorio Catapang Jr. said in an official statement, that the BuCor is the owner of the two hundred seventy (270) hectare land in Tanay, Rizal being contested by the Masungi Georeserve Foundation, and it will utilize the property for its headquarters, including residential sites for its personnel²;

WHEREAS, the Masungi Georeserve is a conservation area and a rustic rock garden tucked in the rainforests of Rizal. Masungi's name is derived from the word "masungki" which translates to "spiked" - an apt description for the sprawling limestone landscape found within³;

WHEREAS, in 2019, the Masungi Georeserve has received an international recognition for its sustainable tourism practices at the annual World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) Awards⁴;

WHEREAS, Ann Dumaliang, co-founder of Masungi Georeserve, said the site being eyed as a relocation site is home to the fragile limestone formations and included in conservation efforts under the Masungi Geopark Project between the Masungi Georeserve Foundation and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), through a valid and binding memorandum of agreement signed by then Environment Secretary Gina Lopez in 2017⁵;

WHEREAS, scientists from the National Museum of the Philippines had previously noted that developing the relocation site will have expensive consequences for the environment⁶;

WHEREAS, the acting BuCor chief added that a transfer certificate of title for the two hundred seventy (270) hectare land in the villages of Kuyumbay, Layban, San Andres and Tinucan in Tanay town was issued in favor of the BuCor on Sept. 28, 2022 and that the parcel of land was originally registered under the Republic of the Philippines and covered by the Original Certificate of Title 3556⁷;

WHEREAS, also, he said that Presidential Proclamation 1158 issued on Sept. 8, 2006, by President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo allocated two hundred seventy (270) hectares of the land as the new site of the New Bilibid Prison, as recommended by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources⁸;

WHEREAS, on the other hand, the Masungi Georeserve Foundation contends that the disputed two hundred seventy (270) hectares of land called "Lot 10" has already been subject to a "joint venture project" as early as 2002 between the DENR and Blue Star Construction and Development, the company funding Masungi, and a memorandum was signed in 2009 by then environmental secretary Lito Atienza urging the DENR regional director to look for an alternative for the relocation of the New Bilibid Prison⁹;

WHEREAS, the Masungi georeserve is a symbol of sustainable development and at the forefront of efforts to conserve, restore, and improve the environment in the face of climate change, which must be protected by the government and private sector at all cost;

WHEREAS, while the initiatives of the Bucor to have a new headquarters and housing for its personnel is reasonable, it is important to weigh the possible consequences of building its headquarters in an Ecotourism site like the Masungi Georeserve, which may affect the environment and tourism in the country;
