RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND RECOGNIZING THE NATIONAL JIU-JITSU TEAM FOR THEIR IMPRESSIVE WIN IN THE 7TH ASIAN JIU-JITSU CHAMPIONSHIP HELD LAST FEBRUARY 24 - 28, 2023 IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has, on several occasions, given recognition and commendation to outstanding Filipinos for their outstanding feats of bringing honor, pride and glory to the country by garnering prestigious awards;

WHEREAS, the 2023 Asian Jiu-Jitsu Championship is considered the most participated in the history of Asian Jiu-Jitsu, with thirty (30) competing countries for the first time, including Thailand, the United Arab Emirates, Bangladesh, Cambodia, Taiwan, India, Indonesia, Iraq, Japan, Iran, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Malaysia, Maldives, Mongolia, Pakistan, Nepal, Palestine, China, the Philippines, South Korea, Saudi Arabia, Singapore, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, and Vietnam, with a total of 581 athletes;

WHEREAS, the National Jiu Jitsu Team has clinched four gold and two bronze medals and finishing 2nd overall in the recently concluded Asian Jiu-Jitsu Championship held in Bangkok, Thailand;

WHEREAS, two-time world champion, Meggie Ochoa bagged gold medal by emerging victorious in the Women's Adult-48kg division;

WHEREAS, three more gold medals were hauled by all female power of Southeast Asian gold medalist Annie Ramirez (57kg), Jenna Kaila Napolis (52kg) and 19-year-old Dylan Valmores (70kg) in their respective divisions;

WHEREAS, Marc Alexander Lim and Andrea Lois Lao won two bronze medals in the Men-69 kg and Women-63kg categories, respectively;

WHEREAS, the exemplar performance of the Philippine Team deserves recognition for bringing honor to the nation, and for inspiring fellow athletes to be the best in their respective disciplines;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to congratulate and recognize the National Jiu-Jitsu Team for their impressive win in the 7th Asian Jiu-Jitsu Championship held last February 24 - 28, 2023 in Bangkok, Thailand.
