## AN ACT DECLARING LA MESA DAM ECOPARK, LOCATED IN BARANGAY FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY, A TOURISM DESTINATION

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The La Mesa Dam Ecopark located in Barangay Fairview, Quezon 2 City, is hereby declared a tourism destination. Pursuant thereto, its development shall be 3 prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules and 4 regulations governing the development of tourism destinations. 5 SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the local government of 6 Quezon City shall, in coordination with the DOT, Department of Environment and Natural 7 Resources and concerned agencies of the government, prepare a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate 8 9 infrastructure and facilities to enhance tourism in the area: Provided, That said development 10 plan shall ensure the preservation and conservation of the natural beauty and resources of the 11 area: Provided, further, That the implementation of the tourism development plan shall be 12 included in the budget of the local government of Quezon City.

1	SEC. 3. The DOT shall assist the local government of Quezon City in the
2	implementation of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in tourism
3	capacity building. It shall also include the La Mesa Dam Ecopark in its national and regional
4	promotion programs.

- SEC. 4. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual budget of the local government of Quezon City. The DOT may augment such allocation with internally-generated funds.
- SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the local government of Quezon City shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned agencies of the government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.
  - SEC. 6. If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
- SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, proclamations, executive orders, proclamations and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
