## AN ACT DECLARING THE PROVINCE OF MARINDUQUE AS THE HOME OF THE MORIONES FESTIVAL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. It is the policy of the State to preserve and promote the country's rich
   history and cultural heritage.
- Pursuant thereto, the Province of Marinduque is hereby declared as the home of the
  Moriones Festival, an annual indigenous re-enactment of the story of a Roman centurion who
  was blind in one eye but was miraculously cured after piercing the side of the crucified Jesus
  Christ. Celebrated since 1807, it is commemorated during the Holy Week and attracts a
  massive number of tourists.
  SEC. 2. The Department of Tourism (DOT) shall feature the Moriones Festival in the
  Province of Marinduque in its national and regional promotion programs.
- 10 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
- 11 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
