AN ACT

CREATING A VAT REFUND MECHANISM FOR NON-RESIDENT TOURISTS, ADDING FOR THE PURPOSE A NEW SECTION 112-A TO THE NATIONAL INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1997, AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. A new Section 112-A is hereby inserted after Section 112 of the National 1 2 Internal Revenue Code of 1997, as amended, to read as follows: "SEC. 112-A. TOURIST VAT REFUND. – A TOURIST SHALL BE 3 ELIGIBLE FOR A VALUE-ADDED TAX (VAT) REFUND ON GOODS 4 ACCREDITED RETAILERS IN THE PURCHASED FROM 5 PHILIPPINES IF SUCH GOODS ARE TAKEN OUT OF THE COUNTRY 6 WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS FROM THE DATE OF PURCHASE, AND 7 THE VALUE OF GOODS PURCHASED PER TRANSACTION 8 AMOUNTS TO AT LEAST THREE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,000.00): 9 PROVIDED, THAT SUCH THRESHOLD MAY BE ADJUSTED 10 CONSIDERING THE ADMINISTRATION COST FOR THE REFUND, 11 THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX, OR OTHER MARKET CONDITIONS, 12

1	AS DETERMINED BY THE SECRETARY OF FINANCE UPON
2	RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECRETARY OF TOURISM AND THE
3	COMMISSIONER OF INTERNAL REVENUE: PROVIDED, FURTHER,
4	THAT THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE REFUND PROCESS SHALL
5	BE CONDUCTED THROUGH ONE OR MORE SERVICE PROVIDERS.
6	"FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A 'TOURIST' SHALL
7	REFER TO A FOREIGN PASSPORT HOLDER, WHO IS A NON-
8	RESIDENT INDIVIDUAL NOT ENGAGED IN TRADE OR BUSINESS IN
9	THE PHILIPPINES."
10	SEC. 2. Implementing Rules and Regulations Within thirty (30) days from the
11	effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Finance shall promulgate the necessary rules and
12	regulations for its effective implementation.
13	SEC. 3. Repealing Clause All laws, decrees, executive orders, implementing rules
14	and regulations, issuances, or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are

and regulations, issuances, or any part thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are deemed repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SEC. 4. Effectivity. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
