AN ACT

DECLARING FEBRUARY 7 OF EVERY YEAR AS "NATIONAL RELIGIOUS FREEDOM APPRECIATION DAY" IN CELEBRATION OF THE WORLD INTERFAITH HARMONY WEEK OF THE UNITED NATIONS

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. February 7 of every year is hereby declared as "National Religious Freedom
Appreciation Day" in celebration of the World Interfaith Harmony Week of the United
Nations.

SEC. 2. It is the declared policy of the State to allow and guard the fundamental right of every person to the free exercise and enjoyment of religious profession and worship underSection5, Article III of the 1987 Philippine Constitution. Accordingly, the constitutional right of every Filipino to profess, practice and propagate religious beliefs must always be recognized, respected and allowed except in cases where there is clear, grave and present danger or threat detrimental to a person's right to life, liberty, or property, public interest, or security.

SEC. 3. To ensure the significance of the National Religious Freedom Appreciation Day, the Council on Interfaith Initiatives under the Office of the President shall, within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, promulgate rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act. SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen days after its publication in the Official
Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
