AN ACT

TO INSTITUTIONALIZE THE SHARED SERVICE FACILITIES (SSF) PROJECT FOR MICRO, SMALL, AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (MSMES) BY AMENDING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6977 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MAGNA CARTA FOR SMALL ENTERPRISES AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9501 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE MAGNA CARTA FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Insert new Sections 16 and 17 under Republic Act No. 6977, as
2	amended, to read as follows, and renumber the succeeding sections accordingly:
3	"SEC. 16. ESTABLISHMENT OF SHARED SERVICE FACILITIES
4	(SSF) FOR MSMES. – IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THE GAPS IN THE
5	PRODUCTION VALUE CHAIN, PROMOTE INNOVATION AMONG
6	MSMES AND ENHANCE THEIR CAPACITIES TO PRODUCE AND
7	OFFER SOPHISTICATED AND DIVERSE PRODUCTS AND
8	SERVICES, THE SHARED SERVICE FACILITIES (SSFS)
9	PROGRAM OF DTI IS HEREBY INSTITUTIONALIZED.
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11	THE DTI SHALL ALSO ESTABLISH SSF – FABRICATION
12	LABORATORIES (SSF-FAB LABS), WHICH REFER TO HIGH-END

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1SSFS EQUIPPED WITH AN ARRAY OF FLEXIBLE COMPUTER-2CONTROLLED TOOLS THAT COVER SEVERAL DIFFERENT3LENGTHS AND SCALE AND VARIOUS MATERIALS, IN AT LEAST4ONE (1) STRATEGIC LOCATION IN EVERY PROVINCE TO5ASSIST MSMES IN THE MANUFACTURING OF NEEDED ASSETS6AND PRODUCTS. THE PRIORITY SHALL BE PROVINCES7WITHOUT EXISTING FAB LABS.

9THE SSF-FAB LABS SHALL BE ATTACHED TO STATE10UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES (SUCS); LOCAL UNIVERSITIES11OR COLLEGES (LUCS); PRIVATE SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND12UNIVERSITIES; AND GOVERNMENT ACADEMIC TRAINING13INSTITUTIONS OF THE PROVINCE AS DETERMINED BY DTI14FOR PROPER MONITORING AND MAINTENANCE."

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"SEC. 17. MONITORING OF PRODUCTIVITY OUTCOMES. – THE 16 IN COORDINATION WITH THE **CONCERNED** 17 DTI, COOPERATORS, LGUS, SUCS, LUCS, PRIVATE SCHOOLS, 18 AND UNIVERSITIES, AND GOVERNMENT 19 COLLEGES ACADEMIC TRAINING INSTITUTIONS IN WHICH THE SSFS 20 AND THE SSF-FAB LABS ARE SITUATED, SHALL SUBMIT AN 21 ANNUAL PROGRESS REPORT TO CONGRESS DETAILING THE 22 **EFFECTIVENESS AND/OR IMPACT OF THE SSFS WHICH SHALL** 23 INCLUDE THE BUDGET UTILIZATION OF THE PROJECT, 24 ADDITIONAL JOBS AND INCOME GENERATED, INDUSTRY 25 ENGAGEMENT, TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER, AND OVERALL 26 GROWTH OF THE BUSINESSES WHICH AVAILED OF THE 27 FACILITIES." 28

Sec. 2. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – Within three (3) months from the effectivity of this Act, the DTI shall promulgate the necessary implementing rules and regulations for the institutionalization and establishment of the SSFs including the guidelines for the partnership with the cooperators, SUCs, LUCs, private schools, colleges and universities, and government academic training institutions where the
 SSFs and SSF-Fab Labs will be established.

Sec. 3. *Appropriations*. – The amounts necessary to carry out the implementation of this Act shall be charged against the current budget of DTI. Thereafter, the funds necessary for the continuous implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).

Sec. 4. *Separability Clause.* - If any portion or provision of this Act is declared
unconstitutional, the remainder of this Act or any provision not affected thereby shall
remain in full force and effect.

10 Sec. 5. *Repealing Clause.* - All laws or parts thereof, decrees, orders, rules and 11 regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified 12 accordingly.

Sec. 6. *Effectivity Clause*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
