1 **WHEREAS**, the Philippines has once again proven its excellence in the field of
2 mathematics as the Philippine team garnered one hundred fourteen (114) awards in
3 the 6th International Mathematics Open for Young Achievers (IMOYA) held in
4 Singapore from March 24 to 27, 2023;

6 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine team showcased their skills and talent in the contest
7 and won a total of eight (8) gold, twenty-five (25) silver, and thirty-one (3) bronze
8 medals in the individual contest, and five (5) champion awards, twenty (20) 1st
9 runners-up, and twenty-five (25) 3rd runners-up awards in the team competition;

11 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino mathletes were also declared top scorers in the
12 individual contest in Grade 9 and Grade 11, respectively, with Giorgio Othello Gumban
13 from the Ateneo de Manila University and Benito Andre Yulo from the Immaculate
14 Conception Academy – Greenhills;

16 **WHEREAS**, the Philippine team also earned five (5) champion awards in the
17 team competition, thanks to the outstanding performance of Yama Raj Maniago from
18 Philippine Science High School – Socskargen Campus, Joshua Miguel Tan from Ateneo
19 de Manila Junior High School, Cara Elise Gohoc from MGC New Life Christian Academy,
20 Ellyce Jae Lim and Sebastian Theo Ong from Philippine Science High School - Eastern


1 Visayas; WHEREAS, the 6th IMOYA drew more than 400 participants from different
