ESTABLISHING A FIFTY (50)-BED SATELLITE HOSPITAL OF
THE EASTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER IN
THE MUNICIPALITY OF CATARMAN, NORTHERN SAMAR, TO BE KNOWN
AS THE EASTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER CATARMAN
SATELLITE HOSPITAL APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The 1987 Philippine Constitution, under Article XIII, Section 11 provides that, "The State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other social services available to all the people at affordable cost. There shall be priority for the needs of the underprivileged, sick, elderly, disabled, women, and children. The State shall endeavor to provide free medical care to paupers."

According to the Philippine Statistics Authority, Eastern Visayas is among the poorest regions in the country in year 2021. This denotes that about 22 in every 100 families in the region were poor or have income that were below the poverty threshold, or the amount needed to buy their basic food and non-food needs. Along with poverty, it contends with lack of infrastructure and social services, including hospitals.

Hence, this bill seeks to establish a satellite hospital under the Eastern Visayas Regional Medical Center (EVRMC) to be located in the Municipality of Catarman, Northern Samar. This will effectively help close the gap in the region's hospital bed capacity as well as ensure wider access to affordable and quality healthcare services particularly in Northern Samar.

In view of the foregoing, the expeditious passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

ESTABLISHING A FIFTY (50)-BED SATELLITE HOSPITAL OF

AS THE EASTERN VISAYAS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER CATARMAN
SATELLITE HOSPITAL APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- **SECTION 1.** A fifty (50)-bed satellite hospital of the Eastern Visayas Regional Medical Center shall be established in the Municipality of Catarman, Northern Samar, to be known as the Eastern Visayas Regional Medical Center-Catarman.
- **SEC. 2.** The Eastern Visayas Regional Medical Center-Catarman shall be under direct administrative and technical supervision of the Department of Health (DOH).
- **SEC. 3.** The DOH shall formulate the necessary guidelines or rules and regulations for its operation as a Level 2 hospital. The DOH shall ensure funding for the acquisition of the land on which the hospital will be established, the construction of the hospital buildings and other complementary infrastructure, facilities and medical equipment, as well as for the costs of the necessary maintenance and personnel services.
- **SEC. 4**. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
- **SEC. 5.** The Secretary of Health, in coordination with the Secretary of the DBM and the Commissioner of the CSC shall, within ninety (90) days from the effectivity of

this Act, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for its effective implementation.

SEC. 6. If any provisions or part of this Act is declared unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SEC. 7. All other laws, decrees, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
