S E N A T E P.S. RES. No. 607

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Introduced by Senator WIN GATCHALIAN

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE SUCCESSIVE ELECTRIC TRANSMISSION SYSTEM DISTURBANCES WITH THE END IN VIEW OF ENSURING RELIABLE AND CONTINUOUS ELECTRIC POWER SUPPLY IN THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9511, otherwise known as the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) franchise, grants to NGCP the privilege to serve act as the national transmission concessionaire over the national grid of the electric power industry;

WHEREAS, the national grid of the electric power industry is the sole backbone for the transmission of electricity throughout the country;

WHEREAS, by virtue of its franchise, NGPC is bound to operate and maintain the transmission system, grid, and related facilities at all times in accordance with industry standards;¹

WHEREAS, on 27 April 2023, the NGCP reported a system disturbance in the Visayas Grid which led to unplanned power blackouts up to twelve (12) hours in the islands of Panay, Guimaras, and Negros which persisted even until 30 April 2023;²

WHEREAS, on 8 May 2023, the NGCP reported red and yellow alerts in the Luzon grid which was due to a tripping of the Bolo-Masinloc 230kV Line 2. This in turn

led to the tripping of two (2) units of the Masinloc Coal Power Plant, thereby causing

a total power loss to the Luzon grid of 1,354 megawatts (MW).³ As a result, brownouts

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WHEREAS, on or about 3:40 PM on 9 May 2023, Meralco reported power supply cuts due to a temporary system imbalance caused by a sudden plant outage.⁵ According to Meralco, the power supply disruption was caused by an automatic load dropping (ALD) of approximately 290 MW which occurred as a result of the tripping of the Duhat-Hermosa 230kV line. This caused the power generating units GMEC 1 (310MW) and Limay 5 & 7 (120MW) to trip. This affected more than 200,000 Meralco customers in Paco and Sta. Mesa in Manila, Caloocan, Malabon, Batangas, Antipolo in Rizal, San Pedro and Biñan in Laguna, and San Rafael and Pulilan in Bulacan;⁶

WHEREAS, the successive transmission system disturbances which has caused inconvenience to communities and losses to businesses is a great cause for concern;

WHEREAS, the NGCP, as the operator of the transmission system in the country, should be held to account for the root cause of these disturbances and be mandated to provide an comprehensive audit of the reliability of the transmission system, grid, and related facilities;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the appropriate Senate Committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the successive system disturbances on the electric transmission system with the end in view of ensuring reliable and continuous electric power supply in the country.
