AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO KYLE DOUGLAS JENNERMANN

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:


SECTION 1. Kyle Douglas Jennermann is hereby granted Philippine citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as the duties and obligations appurtenant thereto, under the Constitution and the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

6 SEC. 2. Kyle Douglas Jennermann shall take the Oath of Allegiance to the Republic 7 of the Philippines before an officer duly authorized to administer the same. The Oath of 8 Allegiance shall be registered with the Bureau of Immigration.

10 SEC. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of Immigration 11 shall issue a Certificate of Naturalization to Kyle Douglas Jennermann who shall 12 thereupon enter into the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

14 SEC 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official* 15 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.

AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO KYLE DOUGLAS JENNERMANN

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to grant Philippine citizenship to Mr. Kyle Douglas Jennermann, in recognition of his contributions to the promotion of the Philippines and its culture.

Mr. Jennermann, known to many as Kulas, is a 34-year-old Canadian citizen who has dedicated his YouTube channel "BecomingFilipino" to featuring the Philippines' natural beauty and promoting the country's culture and identity to the world. With more than one million followers, Kulas has travelled by scooter to a total of eighty provinces in the country, all the while documenting his experiences and interactions and sharing them through his vlogs. He has showcased the country's beautiful beaches, mountains, waterfalls and rivers, and has come to love Filipino culture, immersing himself to the Filipino way of life and even learning the Filipino language. He has been living in the Philippines since 2013 and has written and created thousands of posts actively promoting the country through social media.

Aside from his continuing efforts to promote our country through his channel, Kulas has also helped Filipinos in times of great need, bringing much needed attention to areas that had been badly affected by typhoons and actively involving himself in relief operations in calamity-stricken areas. Such was the case when Typhoon Yolanda hit in 2013, and Mr. Jennermann found himself in the Philippines, contributing to the relief efforts in whatever way he can. He guit his job in Hong Kong, where he was working at an outdoor adventure company, and then flew to Cagayan de Oro where he ended up packing relief goods at a Red Cross station in the city. Together with other friends from the Filipino outdoor community, he also helped in putting up OneTacloban, which was able to raise donations that were used in providing relief to the people of Tacloban. During his stay in the city, he also started documenting the damage in the area, and afterwards would camp out near the tents set up by the United Nations, which was the only place with Internet signal at the time, and upload his videos on YouTube so that his family and friends would know the real situation on the ground and how badly help was needed. To this day, Mr. Jennermann continues to use his platforms in bringing the attention of the world to areas in need of help, recently visiting the town of Upi in Maguindanao, another area that was badly affected by Typhoon Paeng.

Mr. Kyle Douglas Jennermann was born and raised in Vancouver Island, Canada, but in the nine years that he has spent in the Philippines, he has truly become a Filipino. He loves our people, he respects our culture, he promotes our country's natural beauty, and he is proud to call the Philippines his home.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **Section 1.** Mr. Kyle Douglas Jennermann is hereby granted Philippine 2 citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives, as well as the duties and 3 obligations appurtenant thereto under the Constitution and the laws of the 4 Republic of the Philippines.

5 **Sec. 2.** Upon taking his Oath of Allegiance before an officer duly authorized 6 for this purpose, and the registration of the same with the Bureau of Immigration, 7 Mr. Kyle Douglas Jennermann shall enter upon the full enjoyment of his Philippine 8 citizenship.

9 Sec. 3. Upon registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of 10 Immigration shall issue Mr. Kyle Douglas Jennermann his Certificate of 11 Naturalization.

12 **Sec. 4.** This Act shall take effect immediately upon publication in at least 13 two (2) newspapers of general circulation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to grant Philippine citizenship to Kyle Jennermann and giving him all the rights and privileges as well as the duties and obligations thereto under our Constitution and existing laws.


Kyle Jennermann is a Canadian national who found himself enamored with the Philippines. He firmly believes that the world would be a better place to live if people around the world make the Philippines a part of their lives in one way or another.

Stuck with this belief, "Kulas", which is the nickname that Jennermann was given several years ago by one of the "manongs" whom he met in one of his travels, lived with a purpose: introduce the Philippines to the rest of the world through the internet with his vlogs. He set up the YouTube channel called "Becoming Filipino" in order to accomplish this, and through time, effort, and his love for the country, he has become an internet sensation with close to a million subscribers. Through his vlogs, he has created and published thousands of video content showcasing his real-life interactions and connections with the Filipino people and their culture all throughout his eight years of immersive travel across eighty (80) out of the eighty-one (81) provinces.

In view of Kyle Jennermann's contributions to the promotion of Filipino culture and identity to the rest of the world, the immediate approval of this bill is earnestly sought.



Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Kyle Jennermann is hereby granted Philippine citizenship with
 all the rights, privileges and prerogatives appurtenant thereto.

SEC. 2. – After taking and registration of the Oath of Allegiance to the Republic
of the Philippines, Kyle Jennermann shall enter into the full enjoyment of
Philippine citizenship.

8 SEC. 3. – Upon the registration of the Oath of Allegiance, the Bureau of 9 Immigration shall forthwith issue Kyle Jennermann's Certificate of 10 Naturalization.

SEC. 4.- This Act shall take effect immediately fifteen (15) days upon
 publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general
 circulation.
