## **RESOLUTION**

## COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ALL THE FILIPINO MEDALISTS OF THE 32nd SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES FOR BRINGING PRIDE AND HONOR TO THE COUNTRY

WHEREAS, the Southeast Asian (SEA) Games is a biennial multi-sport event involving participants from the current 11 countries of the Southeast Asian region;

WHEREAS, the 32nd SEA Games held in Phnom Penh, Cambodia from May 5 to 17, 2023 is a testament to the enduring cooperation, friendship, and solidarity of the ASEAN countries, serving as a source of pride and unity for all the people of Southeast Asia;

WHEREAS, the Philippines participated in this year's SEA Games with a delegation of over 800 strong Filipino athletes who performed remarkably, winning a total of 58 gold, 85 silver, and 117 bronze medals. This impressive win mustered a 5<sup>th</sup> Place Finish in the final medal tally and bested the country's 52-gold haul last year in Vietnam;

WHEREAS, this year's performance of the Philippines was again historic and momentous as Filipino athletes such as EJ Obiena, Eric Cray, Elreen Ando, Vanessa Sarno, Teia Salvino, Jaymark Rodelas, Dexter Tabique, and many others shattered SEA Games and Philippine records in their respective sports;

WHEREAS, in the same sports meet, Gilas Pilipinas was successful in reclaiming the SEA Games gold medal in the men's 5x5 basketball, while Gilas Women was able to secure the women's 5x5 basketball competition's silver;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Arnis and Taekwondo teams have achieved remarkable success by winning the highest number of gold medals, with each team

securing 6 gold medals. Furthermore, the Athletics team has demonstrated exceptional performance by earning the highest total number of medals, with an impressive haul of 22 medals;

WHEREAS, for their outstanding contribution to the Philippine sports, they are entitled to cash incentives by virtue of Republic Act 10699 or An Act Expanding the Coverage of Incentives Granted to National Athletes and Coaches. SEA Games winners especially the gold medalists will receive P300,000, the silver medalists P150,000, and the bronze medalists P60,000 each;

WHEREAS, under the same law, "national athletes and other athletes who surpass Philippine record or ranking in any measurable international sports competition shall be given cash incentives, the amount of which may be determined by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC);"

WHEREAS, these stellar achievements are product of years of hard training and personal sacrifices by both the athletes and their coaches, who unquestionably deserve recognition and reward;

WHEREAS, this victory is a proud moment for the Philippines, and it is a proof that with huge passion, perseverance, determination, hard work, and sufficient government support, Filipino athletes can conquer the international stage and achieve greater heights;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Senate of the Philippines to commend and congratulate all the Filipino medalists of the 32<sup>nd</sup> Southeast Asian Games for bringing pride and honor to the country.
