AMENDING SECTION 8 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7722 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ACT CREATING THE COMMISSION ON HIGHER EDUCATION, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Anti-Hazing Law of 2018 imposes upon schools the mandatory duty to conduct information dissemination campaigns and orientation programs regarding the ills and consequences of hazing.

In order to implement a more holistic approach to ensuring the compliance of colleges and universities in the performance of their above-mentioned duty, there is a need to give the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) an express power to sanction and impose fines on those colleges and universities who are remiss in their statutory duty.

This proposed measure gives the CHED the power to impose the payment of a fine in the amount of Five Million Pesos (P5,000,000.00) to any school who fails to conduct the required orientation and who fails to submit their compliance report on the same to CHED and to Congress.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate passage of the same is earnestly sought.



Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SEC. 2. A new section to be denominated as Section 11 is hereby inserted in the sameAct after Section 10 to read as follows:

12 "SEC. 11. HAZING VICTIMS TRUST FUND. THERE IS HEREBY CREATED A TRUST FUND TO BE HELD IN TRUST BY THE 13 COMMISSION, THE FUNDS OF WHICH SHALL COME FROM THE 14 15 FINES IMPOSED AGAINST INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING WHO FAIL TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENT TO 16 17 CONDUCT A MANDATORY INFORMATION DISSEMINATION CAMPAIGN AND ORIENTATION PROGRAM AGAINST HAZING, 18 19 AS WELL AS THE FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE CORRESPONDING COMPLIANCE REPORT TO THE COMMISSION AND THE 20 21 CONGRESS."

22 SEC. 3. *Separability Clause.* – If any provision or part of this Act is declared invalid or 23 unconstitutional, the other parts or provisions thereof shall remain valid and effective. SEC. 4. *Repealing Clause.* – Republic Act No. 8049 and all other laws, decrees, executive orders, proclamations, rules or regulations, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Act are hereby amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 5. *Effectivity Clause*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the *Official Gazette* or in at least two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.

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
