AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A MULTI-SPECIES MARINE HATCHERY IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF STA. CATALINA, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS SUR, AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The global declining trend of capture fisheries calls for intensified promotion of aquaculture activities and top potential areas for aquaculture fish production. Aquaculture is growing much faster than capture fisheries. The Philippines now contributes only a little over 1 percent of global farm fish production compared to 5 percent previously. In addition, there is a need to fill the gap in fish production as the estimated requirement for fish fry in the Philippines is about 3.5 billion annually, while local production is only at 2.5 billion a year.

Santa Catalina is a coastal municipality in the province of Ilocos Sur. The municipality has a land area of 9.68 square kilometers or 3.74 square miles which constitutes 0.37% of Ilocos Sur's total area. Its population as determined by the 2020 Census was $14,493.^1$

To strengthen the fishing industry and to provide additional income opportunities to the small fisherfolks of the municipality, this bill is being proposes to establish a multi-species marine hatchery in the Municipality of Sta. Catalina, Province of Ilocos Sur.

In view of the foregoing, the immediate passage of the bill is requested.

AN ACT

ESTABLISHING A MULTI-SPECIES MARINE HATCHERY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF STA. CATALINA, PROVINCE OF ILOCOS SUR, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources of the Department of Agriculture (DA-BFAR), a multi-species marine hatchery in the Municipality of Sta. Catalina, Province of Ilocos Sur.

SEC. 2. Prior to the establishment of the multi-species marine hatchery, the DA-BFAR shall conduct a full-scale feasibility study in support of its construction to comply with the requirements of the Department of Budget and Management.

Within two (2) years after the construction of the multispecies marine hatchery, the DA-BFAR shall, through a memorandum of agreement, transfer its management to the local government of the Municipality of Sta. Catalina, Province of Ilocos Sur. It shall implement a training and phasing-in program for local government personnel on the management and operation of the hatchery.

- **SEC. 3**. The DA-BFAR shall conduct continuing research and experimentation on the breeding and production of marine species, especially as they apply to local conditions, to discover new methods and technologies that will enhance the fishing industry.
- **Sec. 4**. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the conduct of the feasibility study and the consequent establishment of the multi-species marine hatchery in the Municipality of Sta. Catalina, Province of Ilocos Sur, the funding of which shall be included in the General Appropriations Act. The local government unit concerned shall set aside funds from any available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the hatchery.
- **Sec. 5.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, operation, monitoring, and the eventual transfer of the management of the multi-species marine hatchery to the local government of the Municipality of Sta. Catalina, Province of Ilocos Sur.
- **Sec. 6.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
