#### RESOLUTION

# EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF THE SENATE IN RECOGNIZING THE ENDURING AMITY AND COOPERATION BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES AND REPUBLIC OF POLAND AND COMMEMORATING THE 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF ITS DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS

- WHEREAS, the Republic of the Philippines and the Republic of Poland are
   celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations
   between the two States, which began on 22 September 1973<sup>1</sup>;

5 **WHEREAS**, the past five decades has witnessed closer ties between the 6 two countries as demonstrated by the bilateral trade agreement between the 7 Philippines and Poland back in 1977 and the succeeding diplomatic visits 8 throughout the years between government officials of both countries, including 9 members of its respective Parliaments;

11 **WHEREAS**, one of the most recent diplomatic visits of Polish officials in 12 Manila was on 20 September 2022 with the Department of Agriculture (DA) to 13 further enhance the agricultural trade and cooperation of both countries<sup>2</sup>;

- 15 **WHEREAS**, the bilateral trade between the Philippines and Poland has 16 expanded over the years as evidenced by the growth in Poland's export to the

Philippines by US\$284.8 million from US\$18.2 Million in 1995 to US\$303 Million in
 2021 and the considerable increase in Philippine export to Poland by US\$505.5
 million from US\$11.5Million in 1995 to US\$517 Million in 2021<sup>4</sup>;

5 **WHEREAS**, aside from economic and political cooperation, the friendship 6 between the two States was further bolstered with the pursuit of strengthening 7 defense cooperation between the two countries, particularly in logistical 8 requirements, armament, purchase of military equipment, defense industry and 9 technology transfer for the Philippine Armed Forces;<sup>5</sup>

WHEREAS, as a gesture of solidarity and friendship, the Polish people have provided humanitarian assistance for Yolanda victims, raising at least some US\$366,000.00 for the relief and rehabilitation efforts.<sup>6</sup> During the height of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Polish government has also donated some 547,100 doses of vaccines in support of the Philippine government's vaccination drive;<sup>7</sup>

WHEREAS, Poland considers the Philippines as its important and promising
partner in Southeast Asia as Poland expressed its support in ensuring food security
by providing access to Polish agri-food products, and backs the country's plan to
digitalize government operations and further enhance the digital economy;<sup>8</sup>

WHEREAS, the continuing mutual cooperation and friendship between the
 Philippines and Poland have contributed to the promotion of diplomatic relations,
 economic and trade growth, as well as agricultural partnership;

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it hereby resolved by the 27 Senate of the Philippines to recognize the enduring amity and cooperation between 28 the Republic of the Philippines and the Republic of Poland and to commemorate 29 the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of diplomatic relations between the two States;
