RESOLUTION

HONORING AND COMMENDING THE FOUR TUBBATAHA MANAGEMENT OFFICE RANGERS FOR WINNING THE 2023 INTERNATIONAL UNION FOR THE CONSERVATION OF NATURE WORLD COMMISSION ON PROTECTED AREAS INTERNATIONAL RANGER AWARD ON JULY 26, 2023 IN GLAND, SWITZERLAND

WHEREAS, in a ceremony held on July 26, 2023 in Gland, Switzerland, four Tubbataha Management Office (TMO) rangers, Segundo Conales Jr., Noel Bundal, Jeffrey David, and Cresencio Caranay, Jr., were recognized with the International Union for the Conservation of Nature World Commission on Protected Areas (IUCN WCPA) International Ranger Award for their extraordinary commitment to marine conservation;

8 **WHEREAS,** according to the IUCN, the WCPA is the world's premier network 9 of protected and conserved areas expertise. It has over 2,500 members from 140 10 countries, who provide strategic advice to policymakers and work to strengthen 11 capacity and investment for protected areas establishment and management;

WHEREAS, the IUCN WCPA International Ranger Award is given to individuals and teams in recognition of the outstanding work of protected areas rangers around the world and to celebrate the dedication and bravery of people who protect and conserve natural heritage;

WHEREAS, according to tubbatahareefs.org, the Tubbataha Reefs Natural Park (TRNP) is a 97,030-hectare Marine Protected Area in Palawan, the westernmost Philippine province. It is located 150km southeast of Puerto Princesa City, at the heart of the Coral Triangle, the global center of marine biodiversity. The TRNP is a United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization World Heritage Site, and home to more than 181 species of marine life, most of which are either threatened or endangered;

26 **WHEREAS**, the four TMO rangers are the core of the rangers assigned in the 27 TRNP. The award which they received for their dedicated service and commitment as

marine rangers was accompanied by a cash prize of USD10,000 to support the 1 conservation work of their organization; 2

WHEREAS, according to park superintendent, Angelique Songco, these 4 5 individuals have been park rangers for the last 20 years, where around ten 10 years were spent in Tubbataha and they have sacrificed a lot being away from their family 6 and friends, missing significant occasions. She said that aside from safeguarding the 7 country's rich marine biodiversity habitat, the personnel manning the Tubbataha 8 ranger station have also been doubling as snorkeling guides to tourists and even offer 9 extra supplies during rough sea conditions; 10

12 WHEREAS, in a press release by the IUCN, the ranger team are all local community members, who lived in isolation for extended periods far from their families 13 and from support. They have persevered in the face of COVID-19, personal problems, 14 typhoons, injuries, sickness, and threats. Alongside marine research and monitoring, 15 and assisting and educating visitors, the team works tirelessly to intercept illegal 16 fishers, and voluntarily assists in the education and rehabilitation of offenders; 17

WHEREAS, award winner Jeffrey David said that the honor belongs to all park 19 rangers manning the station in Tubbataha Reefs, from Philippine Navy, Philippine 20 Coast Guard, and the municipal government of Cagayancillo, who in one way or 21 another, has contributed to the conservation and protection of the park. He further 22 stated "We never thought that we will get noticed here in the middle of Sulu Sea. This 23 recognition for our efforts here in Tubbataha has given a boost to our confidence to 24 25 perform our jobs better.";

WHEREAS, this international recognition certainly helps TRNP to shine more 27 on the world stage, as well as attests to the dedication in service and commitment of 28 the awardees as marine rangers which ought to inspire Filipinos all over the world. 29 30

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY 31 **THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES,** to honor and commend the awardees of the 32 2023 International Union for Conservation of Nature World Commission on Protected 33 Areas International Ranger Award, namely: 34
