

RESOLUTION

COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE FILIPINO KEGLERS FOR WINNING GOLD MEDALS IN THE 21ST ASIAN YOUTH TENPIN BOWLING CHAMPIONSHIPS HELD AT THE BLU-O RHYTHM & BOWL IN BANGKOK, THAILAND

1 WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 of the Philippine Constitution 2 mandates that "the State shall promote physical education and encourage 3 sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training 4 for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork and 5 excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

WHEREAS, a delegation of talented young Filipino bowlers participated
in the esteemed 21st Asian Youth Tenpin Bowling Championships held in
Bangkok, Thailand;

11 WHEREAS, the Philippine keglers team made a historic feat after 12 securing the overall crown for the first time and bagged two gold medals during 13 the international bowling competition;

15 WHEREAS, Artegal Barrientos secured a gold medal in the boys' masters 16 division, and after teaming up with the crew of Zach Ramin, Stephen Luke 17 Diwa, and Marc Dylan Custodio, they bagged the boys' division championship 18 title.

WHEREAS, Barrientos conquered the Australia's bowler, Blake Walsh, in
the boys' masters final, with a score of 443-349, he is also the first Filipino male
bowler who accomplished the feat since the eighth edition in Kuala Lumpur,
Malaysia in 1996;
