## RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING ALL THE FILIPINO MEDALISTS OF THE 19th ASIAN GAMES

WHEREAS, the Asian Games, also known as Asiad, is an International Olympic
 Committee-recognized multi-sport event held once in every four years and participated
 by numerous countries all over Asia;

WHEREAS, this year, the Philippines sent around 400 strong Filipino athletes to
compete in the 19<sup>th</sup> iteration of the Asian Games held in Hangzhou, People's Republic
of China from September 23 to October 8, 2023;

WHEREAS, the country garnered a total of eighteen (18) medals – four (4) gold medals, two (2) silver medals, and twelve (12) bronze medals. This significant feat secured the Philippines a 17<sup>th</sup> overall finish in the final medal tally out of the 45 countries that took part in this year's Asian Games;

11 WHEREAS, the four (4) gold medals were successfully brought home by EJ 12 Obiena in Pole Vault, Meggie Ochoa in the women's -47 kg jiu-jitsu, Annie Ramirez in 13 the women's -57 kg jiu-jitsu, and the Gilas Pilipinas in the men's 5x5 basketball 14 tournament;

15 WHEREAS, the two (2) silver medals were from Eumir Marcial in the men's 75 16 kg boxing tournament and Arnel Mandal in the men's 56 kg Sanda-Wushu;

17 WHEREAS, the twelve (12) bronze medals were due to the efforts of the 18 following:

WHEREAS, for their outstanding contribution to the Philippine sports, they are 12 entitled to cash incentives by virtue of Republic Act 10699 or An Act Expanding the 13 Coverage of Incentives Granted to National Athletes and Coaches. Asian Games 14 winners in individual events especially the gold medalists will receive P2,000,000, the 15 silver medalists P1,000,000, and the bronze medalists P400,000 each. For 16 competitions with less than five (5) participants per team, the team shall receive the 17 same cash incentives for individual medal winners, to be divided equally among the 18 team members actually present during the competition. For competitions with five (5) 19 or more participants per team, each team member shall receive twenty-five percent 20 (25%) of the cash incentives for individual medal winners; 21

22 WHEREAS, under the same law, "national athletes and other athletes who 23 surpass Philippine record or ranking in any measurable international sports 24 competition shall be given cash incentives, the amount of which may be determined 25 by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC);"

26 WHEREAS, this year's placing is historic being the Philippines' best Asian Games 27 performance since the 1994 Asian Games in Japan 29 years ago, when Filipino athletes 28 secured 14th place with three golds, two silvers, and eight bronze medals. During the 29 same event, the Gilas Pilipinas basketball team, under the leadership of Coach Tim 30 Cone, achieved a momentous victory, marking the first time since 1962 that they 31 emerged triumphant by defeating Jordan in the Asiad basketball championship game;

1 WHEREAS, our athletes' victory not only brought immense pride and joy to the 2 Philippines but also showcased the undeniable talent and sportsmanship of our 3 athletes on the international stage;

WHEREAS, this will also serve as an inspiration to the youth of our nation,
encouraging them to pursue excellence in sports and embrace the values of grit,
discipline, teamwork, and perseverance;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the
Senate of the Philippines to commend and congratulate all the Filipino medalists of
the 19<sup>th</sup> Asian Games.
