



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

#### **RESOLUTION**

CONCURRING IN THE RATIFICATION OF INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION CONVENTION NO. 190 OR THE "CONVENTION CONCERNING THE ELIMINATION OF VIOLENCE AND HARASSMENT IN THE WORLD OF WORK (ILO C190)"

1 **WHEREAS**, Article VII, Section 21 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states 2 that, "No treaty or international agreement shall be valid and effective unless 3 concurred in by at least two-thirds of all the Members of the Senate"; 4 5 WHEREAS, the "International Labour Organization Convention No. 190 or the Convention Concerning the Elimination of Violence and Harassment in the World of 6 Work (ILO C190)" was signed and was adopted by the International Labour 7 Organization (ILO) General Conference in Geneva, Switzerland on 21 June 2019; 8 9 WHEREAS, the ILO C190 is the first common international framework that 10 addresses violence and harassment in the world of work; 11 12 WHEREAS, the ILO C190 applies to all sectors, whether public or private, in 13 14 urban or rural areas, both in the formal and informal economy; 15 WHEREAS, the ratification of the ILO C190 will fortify the Philippine 16

**WHEREAS**, the ratification of the *ILO C190* will fortify the Philippine government's mandate and policy in promoting and protecting the rights of Filiplno

4	WH	EREAS, the ratification of ILO C190 contributes to the performance of key		
5	targets un	der the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, particularly with		
6	respect to	Goal 5 on Gender Equality and Goal 8 on Decent Work and Economic

9	WH	EREAS, the President of the Philippines ratified the Agreement on 13		
10	October 20	23 and has submitted it to the Senate for concurrence, in accordance with		
11	the Constit	ution of the Philippines;

13	WH	EREAS, in the hearing conducted by the Senate Committee on Foreign		
14	Relations o	n 28 November 2023, all of the government agencies present endorsed the		
15	concurrenc	e to the ratification of the Agreement:

4	RESOLVED, further, That "ILO Recommendation 206" should be considered
5	for the effective implementation of ILO C190;

7	RESOLVED, furthermore, That the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations
8	shall conduct technical working group meetings to discuss the post-ratification legal
9	Implications of ILO C190, comprehensive strategy and plan and proposed legislative
10	measures necessary for its effective enforcement and implementation;

12	RESOLVED, finally, That the President of the Philippines may, with the
13	concurrence of the Senate, withdraw from the Agreement.
