MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Justice and Human Rights; and Finance, to which were referred **House Bill No. 6581**, introduced by Representatives Olivarez, Ferrer (J.M.), et al., entitled:

"AN ACT

CREATING THREE (3) ADDITIONAL BRANCHES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRIAL COURT IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL JUDICIAL REGION TO BE STATIONED IN THE CITY OF PARAÑAQUE, METRO MANILA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 27 OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS 'THE JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980', AS AMENDED" have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 6581, be approved with the following amendments:

- On Page 2, line 7, section 2, after the punctuation mark ".", insert a new sentence as follows: "THE SUPREME COURT SHALL ISSUE THE NECESSARY RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT AND, IF WARRANTED, THE REALIGNMENT OF SEATS OF EXISTING BRANCHES AND THEIR TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION"; and
- 2) Finally, on the same page, Section 3, line 13, between the words "staff" and "shall", insert the punctuation mark "," and followed by the phrase: "AS WELL FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AS FUNDS NECESSARY OF **AUTOMATICALLY CREATED PROSECUTOR POSITIONS PURSUANT TO** SECTION 13 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10071 OR THE "PROSECUTION SERVICE ACT OF 2010" AND APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC ATTORNEYS PURSUANT TO SECTION 7 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9406 OR THE "ACT **REORGANIZING AND STRENGTHENING THE PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S** OFFICE (PAO)", RESULTING FROM THE CREATION OF THESE COURTS, **INCLUDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PERSONNEL SERVICES SUCH AS** SALARIES, BENEFITS, AND EMOLUMENTS FOR PROSECUTORS".



AN ACT

CREATING THREE (3) ADDITIONAL BRANCHES OF THE METROPOLITAN TRIAL COURT IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL JUDICIAL REGION TO BE STATIONED IN THE CITY OF PARAÑAQUE, METRO MANILA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 27 OF BATAS PAMBANSA BLG. 129, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS 'THE JUDICIARY REORGANIZATION ACT OF 1980', AS AMENDED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Three (3) additional branches of the Metropolitan Trial Court in the National Capital Judicial Region are hereby created and stationed in the City of Parañaque, Metro Manila.

The Supreme Court shall assign the respective branch numbers for the newly 1 created branches of the Metropolitan Trial Court. 2

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SEC. 2. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, in coordination with the Secretary 4 of the Department of Justice, shall immediately include in the Court's program the 5 operationalization of the additional branches of the Metropolitan Trial Court in the City of Parañaque, Metro Manila.

SEC. 3. The funds necessary for the implementation of this Act, including 9 appropriations for personnel services such as salaries, benefits and emoluments for 10 judges and court personnel, court operations under maintenance and other operating 11 expenses (MOOE), and provisions for Halls of Justice or courtrooms to accommodate 12 judges and court staff, shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. 13

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SEC. 4. Section 27 of Batas Pambansa Blg. 129, otherwise known as "The Judiciary Reorganization Act of 1980", as amended, and all other laws, rules and regulations 16 which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified 17 accordingly. 18

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SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official 20 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation. 21
