A RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE IMPLEMENTATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OF THE LEGAL INSTRUMENTS ISSUED BY THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION, WITH THE END IN VIEW OF FORMULATING STANDARDS TO DISCERN WHICH OF THE ISSUANCES ISSUED BY THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION SHOULD PASS SENATE SCRUTINY BEFORE THEIR IMPLEMENTATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

WHEREAS, Section 21, Article VII of the 1987 Philippine 2 Constitution provides that "No treaty or international agreement shall be 3 valid and effective unless concurred in by at least two-thirds of all the 4 Members of the Senate"; 5

WHEREAS, the Philippines, one of the founders of the World Health 7 Organization (WHO), joined the WHO on 9 July 1948. Since then, the 8 WHO has been closely collaborating with the Philippine Government 9 through the Department of Health (DOH) in advancing public health in the 10 $country^{1}$; 11

WHEREAS, in the wake of the crisis caused by the COVID-19 13 pandemic, the WHO initiated a "reform process" which will bring about 14 significant changes to all 194 member-states of the WHO. Commencing in 15

1 2021, negotiations have been ongoing for the crafting of two legal 2 instruments, namely, (1) a new Pandemic Treaty²; and (2) significant 3 amendments to the already existing International Health Regulations 4 $(IHR)^3$. The drafting of these international legal documents is about to be 5 finalized with final vote thereon expected sometime in May 2024 and with 6 the same taking effect a year after in May 2025⁴;

8 WHEREAS, it must be recalled that the WHO was guilty of 9 mismanagement of the COVID-19 outbreak as shown, for example, by the 10 following facts: (1) unjustified delays in informing member states about a 11 potentially serious disease outbreak in Wuhan, China, and (2) repeated 12 grossly inaccurate or misleading claims about the transmissibility of the 13 virus⁵;

WHEREAS, it must also be recalled that the Department of Health said that it received reports that COVID-19 vaccination data from the Philippines "housed within the WHO" have been compromised and leaked. The Department of Information and Communications Technology said vaccination data from the Philippines have been uploaded to the dark web following a supposed cyberattack on the WHO database⁶;

WHEREAS, the DOH, has been the *de facto* implementer of policies issued by the WHO. By way of example, just last October 2023, the DOH, in collaboration with the WHO, launched the 2024-2028 Philippine Council for Mental Health (PCMH) Strategic Framework to guide the development and implementation of mental health policies, programs, and services to

address the significant burden of mental illness and improve mental health
and well-being in the country⁷;

WHEREAS, leaving this matter uninvestigated will lead to granting the WHO unbridled power to influence our national policies on health. This presents a clear and present danger to national sovereignty, bearing in mind as well, the strong lingering doubts as to the competence or integrity of the WHO⁸;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as it is hereby resolved, 11 to direct the appropriate Senate Committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of 12 legislation, on the implementation by the Department of Health of the legal 13 instruments issued by the World Health Organization, with the end in view 14 of formulating standards to discern which of the issuances issued by the 15 World Health Organization should pass Senate scrutiny before their 16 implementation by the Department of Health.
