## Introduced by SENATOR RONALD "BATO" DELA ROSA

## RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC ORDER AND DANGEROUS DRUGS TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE ALLEGED INVOLVEMENT OF A PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) PERSONNEL ON THE TRAGIC SHOOTOUT IN COTABATO CITY, AND THE ALLEGED MANIPULATION SURROUNDING THE INVESTIGATION OF THE INCIDENT

WHEREAS, Section 5, Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that, "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";

WHEREAS, *Republic Act No. 6975* mandated the Philippine National Police to enforce all laws and ordinance relative to the protection of lives and properties; and maintain peace and order and take all necessary steps to ensure public safety, among others;

WHEREAS, on 23 October 2023, a tragic shootout incident transpired in Barangay Rosary Heights 12, Cotabato City, which resulted in multiple injuries and the untimely demise of three (3) individuals. Among those who perished were Alfarr Ayunan, a candidate for barangay councilor in Kalangalan 2; Nur-Moctaqin Butucan, a candidate for barangay councilor in Rosary Heights 12; and Faisal Abas, a resident of Kalanganan 2;

WHEREAS, the incident led to the apprehension of twelve (12) individuals, including PMSG Pauti Dianal Mamalapat of Maguindanao Del Sur; Julahidin Ledesla Abdul, also known as "Boyong", a candidate for Barangay chairman in Rosary Heights 12; Jayson Mangudad Bansua; Surin Alon Kamad; Daniel Gumat Paguital; Nordin Gueamel Alay; Mishal Malang Mamalapat; Abedin Saban Guinat; Buts Saban Tepay; Dixie Mahinay Garcia; Arman Mamalangkal; and Roda Midtimbang Bansuan;

WHEREAS, on 20 November 2023, Mayor Mohammad Aii Dela Cruz Matabalao of Cotabato City, wrote a letter to the undersigned stating specific allegations raised by Barangay Captain Bimbo Ayunan Pasawiran in connection with the shootout incident;

WHEREAS, in his letter, Mayor Matabalao claimed that there were irregularities committed by members of the PNP during the course of investigation of the 23 October 2023 shootout incident;

WHEREAS, Mayor Matabalao alleged that paraffin test results were manipulated by the Scene of the Crime Operatives (SOCO); police reports were fabricated to justify the operations against three (3) members of the Ayunan clan; and that certain PNP personnel planned to plant evidence on Barangay Captain Bimbo Ayunan Pasawiran and orchestrated his demise;

WHEREAS, there was also disturbing claim of disruption of peace and order in Cotabato City by the PNP, and the alleged influence of "higher authorities" on the illegal actions of the PNP personnel;

WHEREAS, the alleged involvement of a PNP personnel and concerning reports of manipulation in the investigative process cast doubt on the integrity our law enforcement agencies;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to determine the adequacy of laws, rules and regulations being implemented by the PNP and the need to review the current PNP

operational guidelines and protocols in performing their sworn duty to serve and protect, in order not to undermine the people's trust towards law enforcement personnel;

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, as it is hereby resolved, to direct the Senate Committee on Public Order and Dangerous Drugs to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the alleged involvement of a Philippine National Police (PNP) personnel on the tragic shootout in Cotabato City, and the alleged manipulation surrounding the investigation of the incident.
