

RESOLUTION

CONCURRING IN THE RATIFICATION OF THE 2005 CONVENTION ON THE PROTECTION AND PROMOTION OF THE DIVERSITY OF CULTURAL EXPRESSIONS

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 21 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that, "No treaty or international agreement shall be valid and effective unless concurred in by at least two-thirds of all the Members of the Senate";

WHEREAS, the *2005 Convention on the Protection and Promotion of the Diversity of Cultural Expressions* (Convention) was adopted by the Parties on 20 October 2005 in Paris, France;

WHEREAS, under the Convention, Parties reaffirm their sovereign right to formulate and implement their respective cultural policies, adopt measures to protect and promote the diversity of cultural expressions, and strengthen international cooperation, in conformity with the Charter of the United Nations and the principles of international law, including principles that protect human rights and fundamental freedoms;

WHEREAS, the Convention provides that developed countries shall facilitate cultural exchanges with developing countries by granting preferential treatment to artists and other cultural professionals and practitioners, as well as the cultural goods

4	WHI	EREAS , the Convention provides for the establishment of an International	
5	Fund for Cultural Diversity, in accordance with the financial regulations of the United		
6	Nations Edu	ucational, Scientific and Cultural Organization; and

8	WHI	EREAS, the benefits of the Convention include the balanced flow of cultural	
9	goods and services, increased mobility of artists and cultural professionals worldwide,		
10	and the integration of cultural activities in the creation of frameworks, for the purpose		
11	of achieving	g the Sustainable Development Goals;

13		EREAS, the President of the Philippines ratified the Agreement on 14	
14	August 2023 and has submitted it to the Senate for concurrence, in accordance with		
15	the Constitu	ution;

17		EREAS, in the hearing conducted by the Senate Committee on Foreign	
18	Relations on 14 February 2024, the following government agencies endorsed the		
19	concurrence	e to the ratification of the Agreement:
