AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE AKLAN PIÑA MUSEUM AND CULTURAL CENTER IN THE MUNICIPALITY KALIBO, PROVINCE OF OF AKLAN, ITS SATELLITE CENTERS, **DEFINING** ITS PURPOSES. AND APPROPRIATING **FUNDS** THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. Short Title. This Act shall be known as
- 2 "The Aklan Piña Museum and Cultural Center Act".
- 3 Sec. 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared
- 4 the policy of the State to conserve, promote, and popularize
- 5 the nation's historical and cultural heritage and resources,

1 as well as artistic creations. Towards this end, measures

2 that ensure the achievement of this stated policy shall be

3 pursued.

Sec. 3. Establishment of the Aklan Piña Museum and 4 Cultural Center (the "Center"). – There is hereby 5 established a museum and cultural center for Aklan Piña 6 7 in the Municipality of Kalibo, Province of Aklan, to 8 safeguard and promote the Aklan Piña handloom weaving and its value as a cultural expression of the Aklanon 9 10 culture, ensure continued research and development of the 11 Aklan Piña textile and other related products for sustainable livelihood, ensure a sustainable source of raw 12 material, provide a venue to train and enhance knowledge 13 14 and skills of the younger generation on Aklan Piña, and undertake other activities to broaden appreciation on 15 Aklan Piña handloom weaving and increase market access 16 17 of its products. Satellite centers may also be established to 18 encourage the development of the Piña weaving and textile beyond the Province of Aklan. 19

1	Sec. 4. Coordination and Supervision. – In
2	coordination with the Provincial Government of Aklan and
3	the Municipal Government of Kalibo, the Association of
4	Aklan Piña Weavers, the UNESCO National Commission
5	of the Philippines (UNACOM), the National Commission
6	for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), and the National
7	Museum of the Philippines (NMP) shall: spearhead the
8	establishment of the Center and supervise the same; take
9	charge of the safeguarding, development, and promotion of
10	the Aklan Piña handloom weaving; and develop the
11	creative industry on the Aklan Piña textile and other
12	products, in partnership with the Department of Trade and
13	Industry (DTI) and the Department of Science and
14	Technology (DOST). The Department of Agriculture (DA)
15	shall take charge of the propagation of Red Spanish
16	pineapple or <i>Pinya Bisaya</i> , the raw material of Aklan Piña.
17	Concerned public and private institutions with similar
18	interests shall also be sought for technical assistance or
19	donations in cash or in kind to enable the Center to carry
20	out and discharge its duties and functions.

1	SEC.	5.	Functions.	-	The	Center	shall	perform	the
2	following f	unc	ctions:						

3 (a) Maintain a site in the Municipality of Kalibo 4 which will host a museum, an innovation and training hall, 5 an arts hall and theater, and other facilities as necessary

for the intent of the Center:

- 7 (b) Heighten appreciation of the Aklanon on the value
 8 of Aklan Piña handloom weaving being inscribed in the
 9 Representative List of Intangible Cultural Heritage of
 10 Humanity;
- 11 (c) Cultivate and enhance public interest in, and 12 appreciation of the Aklan Piña handloom weaving;
- (d) Encourage organizations, associations, or societies
 to support weavers and aspiring weavers and/or farmers
 planting *Pinya Bisaya*;
- 16 (e) Support production of artistic works in visual arts,
 17 music, dance, literature, design, media arts, and
 18 publication to promote appreciation of Aklan Piña
 19 handloom weaving and the Western Visayas culture;

- 1 (f) Conduct research on product development and
- 2 marketing of Aklan Piña handloom weaving; and
- (g) Perform such other functions necessary for the
 achievement of the intent and purposes of this Act.
- 5 SEC. 6. Provision of Location. The Provincial
- 6 Government of Aklan or the Municipal Government of
- 7 Kalibo shall provide the land necessary for the
- 8 establishment of the Center and its ancillary offices and
- 9 facilities.
- 10 SEC. 7. Staffing. The Office of Aklan Piña Museum
- 11 and Cultural Center (OAPMCC) is hereby created to
- 12 oversee the Center and ensure the implementation of this
- 13 Act. The OAPMCC shall be lodged in the NCCA and
- 14 headed by a Director appointed by the Commission.
- 15 SEC. 8. Appropriations. The amount necessary for
- 16 the preparatory phase of the establishment of the Center
- 17 shall be charged against the current year's budget of the
- 18 NCCA. Thereafter, such amount as may be necessary for
- 19 the continued implementation of this Act shall be included
- 20 in the annual General Appropriations Act.

- 1 Sec. 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations. -
- 2 Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the
- 3 NCCA, in coordination with all the concerned agencies of
- 4 the government, shall promulgate the necessary rules and
- 5 regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
- 6 SEC. 10. *Effectivity*. This Act shall take effect fifteen
- 7 (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a
- 8 newspaper of general circulation.
