RESOLUTION CONFERRING THE PHILIPPINE SENATE MEDAL OF EXCELLENCE TO 2024 PARIS OLYMPICS BRONZE MEDALIST AIRA VILLEGAS

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 110 establishes the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence in order to recognize, honor and commend outstanding Filipinos for their exemplary service, outstanding achievements and invaluable contributions to nation-building;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence is conferred upon

Filipinos who are awarded the Nobel Prize, Pulitzer Prize, the A.M. Turing Award, the Ramon Magsaysay Award, or an Olympic medal;

WHEREAS, Aira Villegas is a 29-year-old female boxer from Tacloban City who won the bronze medal in the women's 50-kg boxing in the 2024 Summer Olympics in Paris, France;

WHEREAS, Villegas kicked off the campaign of the Philippine boxing team with a unanimous win (5-0) against Morocco's Yasmine Mouttaki, a bronze medalist in the IBA Women's World Boxing Championships, on 29 July 2024 (Philippine time). In the preliminary round of 32, Villegas was off to a rousing start with the five judges ruling in her favor with the following scores: 30-27, 29-28, 29-28, and 29-28;

WHEREAS, the 5'2" Filipina southpaw celebrated her birthday with a stunning victory against Roumaysa Boualam of Algeria, two-time African Games champion, in the preliminary round of 16. Villegas secured another convincing 5-0 win via 30-27, 29-28, 29-28, 30-27 scores;

WHEREAS, Villegas guaranteed another podium finish for the Philippines
when she took down home bet Wassila Lkhadiri of France in the quarterfinal bout
held in North Paris Arena in 04 August 2024 (Philippine time). The Filipino fighter
emerged victorious via a gripping split decision win (3-2) following a tight scoresheet
of 28-29, 28-29, 30-27, 29-28, and 28-29;

WHEREAS, Villegas gave a gallant fight against 2021 Tokyo Olympics silver medalist Buse Naz Cakiroglu of Türkiye to bag bronze during semifinal match held in Roland-Garros Studium in 07 August 2024 (Philippine time);

WHEREAS, Villegas, a bronze medalist at 2019 Southeast Asian (SEA) Games, delivered an astounding performance in her Olympic debut in Paris and secured the country's multiple medal success from consecutive Olympics for the first time in history following Carlos Edriel Yulo's first gold medal win in men's floor exercise event in artistic gymnastics in 03 August 2024, and the four medal haul at the Tokyo Olympics in 2021;

WHEREAS, Villegas exemplifies the Filipinos' grit, tenacity and unyielding spirit in conquering formidable foes and adversities. Moreover, her glorious victory proves that the Philippines continues to be a powerhouse and a force to be reckoned with in boxing;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate, to confer the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence to Aira Villegas for her outstanding achievement of winning the country's bronze medal in the 2024 Paris Olympics, thus bringing honor and prestige to the Republic of the Philippines and serving as an inspiration to the Filipino people.
