





AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY MAPUTI,
MUNICIPALITY OF BANAYBANAY, PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL TO BE
KNOWN AS THE MAPUTI NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision of the Department of
2 Education, a national high school in Barangay Maputi, Municipality of Banaybanay, Province
3 of Davao Oriental to be known as the Maputi National High School.
4

5 SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's
6 program the operationalization of the Maputi National High School, the funding of which
7 shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.
8

9 SEC. 3. Within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act, the Secretary of
10 Education shall formulate the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.
11 Such implementing rules and regulations shall provide for the school's organization,
12 administration, operations and management, in accordance with Republic Act No. 9155, or
13 the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001", Republic Act No. 10533, or the "Enhanced
14 Basic Education Act of 2013", and other basic education-related laws.

16 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
17 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
