**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

## INTRODUCED BY HON. MANNY VILLAR

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUBUGAN, PROVINCE OF ILOILO TO BE KNOWN AS THE LANAG NORTE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department Education, a National High School in the Municipality of Tubungan, Province of Iloilo, to be known as the Lanag Norte National High School.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of Education shall take the necessary steps for the establishment of the school so as to make it operational during the first school term after the effectivity of this Act.

SECTION 3. The amount necessary for implementation of this Act shall be charged to the appropriations of the Department of Education under the current General Appropriations Act. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for the operations and maintenance shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SECTION 4. The amount necessary to carry for the effective implementation of this Act shall be charged to the appropriations for the Department of Health under the current General Appropriations Act. Thereafter, it shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon approval.
