EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the existing extension office of the Land Transportation Office (LTO) in the Municipality of Guimbal, Province of Iloilo into a Class "D" District Office.

At present, the existing LTO extension office is grossly understaffed, with only two (2) employees to handle an annual volume transaction of 2,992 for motor vehicle registration, and issuance and renewal of driver's license. The inevitable result is inefficiency and long-drawn delay in the work.

Due to the size of its clientele, which includes not only Iloilo City residents, but also those from the eastern part of the Province of Antique, and the increasing demand for better facilities necessary for a better quality of service, it is imperative that a bigger office and additional manpower be provided for the Municipality of Guimbal

In view of the foregoing considerations, early approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CLASS "D" DISTRICT OFFICE OF THE LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF GUIMBAL, PROVINCE OF ILOILO

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department of Transportation and Communications, a Class "D" District Office of the Land Transportation Office (LTO) in the Municipality of Guimbal, Province of Iloilo.

SECTION 2. The properties, records, equipment, facilities, assets, and liabilities of the LTO extension office shall be transferred to the Class "D" LTO District Office thus established. Subject to Civil Service Laws, all personnel of the extension office shall be absorbed by the newly established District Office.

SECTION 3. The amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated for the proper implementation of this Act to be charged to the appropriations for the Department of Transportation and Communications under the current General Appropriations Act. Thereafter, such sum as may be necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the District Office shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon approval.
