RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING SENATOR JOKER P. ARROYO TO ARGUE, TOGETHER WITH THE COUNSEL-OF-RECORD, THE CASE OF THE SENATE OF THE PHILIPPINES IN THE PETITION IT FILED QUESTIONING THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 464

WHEREAS, on 11 October 2005, the Senate represented by seventeen Senators filed a petition for certiorari and prohibition with application for issuance of a temporary restraining order /preliminary injunction to declare null and void and enjoin the enforcement of Executive Order No. 464, docketed as G.R. No. 169777;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court En Banc, in a Resolution dated 17 January 2006, resolved to set the case for ORAL ARGUMENT on 21 February 2006 at 1:00 p.m. at the New Session Hall, New Supreme Court Building, Manila; Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, as it hereby resolves to authorize Senator Joker P. Arroyo to argue, together with the counsel-of-record, the case of the Senate of the Philippines in the petition it filed questioning the constitutionality of Executive Order No. 464.
