A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS OF THE PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, July 2006 has been declared by the National Disaster Coordinating Council as National Disaster Consciousness Month, with the theme, "Itaguyod ang Kaunlaran ng Bayan, Kalamidad ay Paghandaan";

WHEREAS, the economic development of a country is hampered, when it is hit by a disaster;

WHEREAS, the recent tsunami in Indonesia posting a current death toll of 531, has again raised concerns that the warning system being installed after a similar disaster hit it in 2004, is still in its early stages;

WHEREAS, the possibility of a tsunami hitting the Philippines is not discounted, as it is situated in the Pacific Ring of Fire, where earthquakes are a frequent occurrence;

WHEREAS, the spate of incidences, which have hit the Philippines in the past few weeks, such as the Baguio landslide; and the increased volcanic activity of Mt. Bulusan, Mt. Mayon and Taal Volcano have put in issue the state of disaster preparedness of the country;

WHEREAS, the unquantifiable human cost of disasters can only be mitigated, if not averted, by sufficient disaster preparation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Senate of the Philippines direct the appropriate Senate committee to investigate, in aid of legislation, the disaster preparedness of the Philippines.
