

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to establish a National High School in Barangay Malaruhatan, Municipality of Lian, Province of Batangas to be known as the Lian National High School and appropriating funds therefore.



**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY
MALARUHATAN, MUNICIPALITY OF LIAN, PROVINCE OF BATANGAS TO
BE KNOWN AS THE LIAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR**

*Be enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress
assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Establishment of a National High School.* – There is hereby
2 established, under the supervision of the Department of Education, a national
3 high school in Barangay Malaruhatan, Municipality of Lian, Province of Batangas
4 to be known as the Lian National High School.

5 SEC. 2. *Appropriations.* – The Secretary of Education shall
6 immediately include in the Department's Program the operationalization of the
7 Lian National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the annual
8 General Appropriations Act.

9 SEC. 3. *Implementation.* – The Secretary of Education shall issue
10 such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this
11 Act.

12 SEC. 4. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
13 its publication in the Official Gazette.
