## HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

## H. No. 1829

BY REPRESENTATIVES PLAZA, DATUMANONG, MACARAMBON, SERAPIO CABILAO AND ABAYON
AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO REV. FR. ULRICI H. SCHLECHT, SVD
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
SECTION 1. Rev. Fr. Ulrich H. Schlecht is hereby granted Philippine
citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives appurtenant thereto.
SEC.2. Upon the taking and registration of the Oath of Allegiance to the
Republic of the Philippines before the Bureau of Immigration and the issuance
to him of the Certificate of Naturalization, Rev. Fr. Ulrich H. Schlecht shall
enter upon the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.
SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
