AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO MICHAEL G.J.
GLEISSNER

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Michael G.J. Gleissner is hereby granted Philippine
2 citizenship with all the rights, privileges and prerogatives appurtenant thereto.

3 SEC. 2. Upon the taking and registration of the oath of allegiance to the
4 Republic of the Philippines before the *Bureau of Immigration* and the issuance
5 to him of the Certificate of Naturalization, Michael G.J. Gleissner shall enter
6 upon the full enjoyment of Philippine citizenship.

7 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
