4 an independent national high school to be known as the Golden Acres National

I	SEC. 2. Transfer of Assets and Liabilities All personnel, assets,
· 2	liabilities and records of the Golden Acres High School Annex are hereby
3	transferred to and absorbed by the Golden Acres National High School.
4	SEC. 3. Appropriations The Secretary of Education shall
5	immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the
6	Golden Acres National High School, the initial funding of which shall be
7	charged against the current year's appropriations of the Las Piñas National
8	High School - Golden Acres High School Annex, Thereafter, the amount
9	necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the
10	annual General Appropriations Act.
11	SEC. 4. Implementation. – The Secretary of Education shall issue such
12	rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.
13	SEC. 5. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
14	its publication in the Official Gazette.
