## EXPLANATORY NOTE

Article II, Section 16, of the Constitution provides:

"The State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature"

The proximity of landfills/garbage dumps to institutions of public or private education is a vital concern to the safety and health of students. Prohibiting the issuance of permits for landfills within twenty kilometers of educational institutions allows for a safe environment essential for learning.

The 1-hectare open dumpsite in Los Baños is located at the buffer zone of the Mt. Makiling Forest Reserve between the Saran Creek and a private property along the Jamboree site and National Road
