**AN ACT
DECLARING MARCH ONE OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL WORKING
HOLIDAY TO BE KNOWN AS
NATIONAL FARMERS AND FISHERFOLKS DAY**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in
Congress assembled:*

Section 1. The first day of March of every year is hereby declared as a special working holiday to be known as "*National Farmers' and Fisherfolks Day*"

Section 2. To ensure meaningful observance of the holiday as herein declared, all heads of government agencies and instrumentalities, including government-owned and controlled corporations especially those that are dealing directly with the farmers as well as local government units, and employers in the private sector shall encourage and afford sufficient time and opportunities for their employees to engage and participate in any activity conducted within the premises of their respective offices or establishments in support and sympathy to farmers across the country to celebrate "*National Farmers and Fisherfolks Day*"

Section 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
