AN ACT

GRANTING FREE HOSPITALIZATION TO SENIOR CITIZENS IN ANY GOVERNMENT HOSPITAL, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE, SECTION FOUR (e) OF REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED SEVENTY-FOUR HUNDRED AND THIRTY-TWO."

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

Section 1. Section Four, Subsection (e) of Republic Act Numbered Seventy-Four Hundred and Thirty-Two is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 4 Privileges for the Senior Citizens.- The senior citizens shall be entitled the following:

"XXX

(e) Free medical and dental services and FREE HOSPITALIZATION AND CONFINEMENT in government [establishment] HOSPITAL anywhere in the country, subject to guidelines to be issued by the Department of Health, the GOVENRMENT SERVICE INSURANCE SYSTEM AND SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM."

Sec. 2. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
