OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW"**

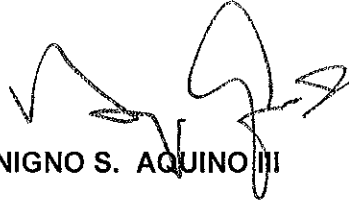

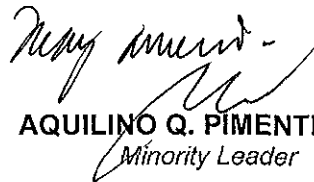

**AN ACT
AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ACT NO. 4103, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE
KNOWN AS THE INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act No. 4103, as amended, otherwise known as the
2 Indeterminate Sentence Law, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3 Sec. 2. This Act shall not apply to persons convicted of offenses punished with
4 death penalty or life-imprisonment; to those convicted of treason, conspiracy or
5 proposal to commit treason; to those convicted of misprision of treason, rebellion,
6 sedition or espionage; to those convicted of piracy; TO THOSE CONVICTED OF
7 CRIMINAL OFFENSES AGAINST A MINOR, WHICH IS COMPARABLE TO OR
8 EXCEEDS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: KIDNAPPING OF A MINOR, EXCEPT BY
9 A PARENT; FALSE IMPRISONMENT OF A MINOR, EXCEPT BY A PARENT;
10 CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT TOWARD A MINOR; SOLICITATION OF A

1 MINOR TO ENGAGE IN SEXUAL CONDUCT; USE OF A MINOR IN A SEXUAL
2 PERFORMANCE; SOLICITATION OF A MINOR TO PRACTICE PROSTITUTION;
3 ANY CONDUCT THAT BY ITS NATURE IS A SEXUAL OFFENSE AGAINST A
4 MINOR; AND PRODUCTION OR DISTRIBUTION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY; to
5 those who are habitual delinquents; to those who have escaped from confinement or
6 evaded sentence; to those who having been granted conditional pardon by the Chief
7 Executive shall have violated the terms thereof; to those whose maximum term of
8 imprisonment does not exceed one year, not to those already sentenced by final
9 judgment at the time of approval of this Act, except as provided in Section 5 hereof.

10 SEC. 2. *Separability Clause.* - If any provision of this Act is held invalid or
11 unconstitutional, the remainder of the Act or the provision not otherwise affected
12 shall remain valid and subsisting.

13 SEC. 3. *Repealing Clause.* - Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive
14 order, letter of instruction, administrative rule or regulation contrary to or
15 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed, modified or amended
16 accordingly.

17 SEC. 4. *Effectivity Clause.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
18 publication in the Official Gazette or at least two (2) newspapers of general
19 circulation.
