AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ACT NO. 4103, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE INDETERMINATE SENTENCE LAW

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of Act No. 4103, as amended, otherwise known as the
- 2 Indeterminate Sentence Law, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 2. This Act shall not apply to persons convicted of offenses punished with
- 4 death penalty or life-imprisonment; to those convicted of treason, conspiracy or
- 5 proposal to commit treason; to those convicted of misprision of treason, rebellion,
- 6 sedition or espionage; to those convicted of piracy; TO THOSE CONVICTED OF
- 7 CRIMINAL OFFENSES AGAINST A MINOR, WHICH IS COMPARABLE TO OR
- 8 EXCEEDS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: KIDNAPPING OF A MINOR, EXCEPT BY
- 9 A PARENT; FALSE IMPRISONMENT OF A MINOR, EXCEPT BY A PARENT;
- 10 CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONDUCT TOWARD A MINOR; SOLICITATION OF A

- 1 MINOR TO ENGAGE IN SEXUAL CONDUCT; USE OF A MINOR IN A SEXUAL
- 2 PERFORMANCE; SOLICITATION OF A MINOR TO PRACTICE PROSTITUTION;
- 3 ANY CONDUCT THAT BY ITS NATURE IS A SEXUAL OFFENSE AGAINST A
- 4 MINOR; AND PRODUCTION OR DISTRIBUTION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY; to
- 5 those who are habitual delinquents; to those who have escaped from confinement or
- 6 evaded sentence; to those who having been granted conditional pardon by the Chief
- 7 Executive shall have violated the terms thereof; to those whose maximum term of
- 8 imprisonment does not exceed one year, not to those already sentenced by final
- 9 judgment at the time of approval of this Act, except as provided in Section 5 hereof.
- 10 SEC. 2. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Act is held invalid or
- 11 unconstitutional, the remainder of the Act or the provision not otherwise affected
- 12 shall remain valid and subsisting.
- SEC. 3. Repealing Clause. Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive
- 14 order, letter of instruction, administrative rule or regulation contrary to or
- inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed, modified or amended
- 16 accordingly.
- 17 SEC. 4. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
- 18 publication in the Official Gazette or at least two (2) newspapers of general
- 19 circulation.
