## AN ACT AMENDING ARTICLE 98 OF ACT NO. 3815, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED PENAL CODE

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Art. 98 of Act No. 3815, as amended, otherwise known as the Revised Penal Code, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Art. 98. Special time allowance for loyalty. - A deduction of one fifth of the period of his sentence shall be granted to any prisoner who, having evaded the service of his sentence under the circumstances mentioned in Article 158 of this Code, gives himself up to the authorities within 48 hours following the issuance of a proclamation announcing the passing away of the calamity or catastrophe referred to in said article. A DEDUCTION OF TWO FIFTHS OF THE PERIOD OF HIS SENTENCE SHALL BE GRANTED IN CASE SAID PRISONER CHOSE TO STAY IN THE PLACE OF HIS

- 4 SEC. 2. Repealing Clause. Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive
- 5 order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule or regulation contrary to or
- 6 inconsistent with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed, modified or amended
- 7 accordingly.
- 8 SEC. 3. Effectivity Clause. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
- 9 publication in the Official Gazette or at least two (2) newspapers of general
- 10 circulation.
