[REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11632]

- AN ACT SEPARATING THE MALINTA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL – PINALAGAD ANNEX IN SITIO PINALAGAD, BARANGAY MALINTA, VALENZUELA CITY, METRO MANILA FROM THE MALINTA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS PINALAGAD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR
- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Malinta Elementary School – Pinalagad Annex in Sitio Pinalagad, Barangay Malinta, Valenzuela City, Metro Manila is hereby separated from the Malinta Elementary School and converted into an independent elementary school to be known as Pinalagad Elementary School.

SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Malinta Elementary School – Pinalagad Annex are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Pinalagad Elementary School. SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the Department's program the operationalization of the Pinalagad Elementary School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current year's appropriation of the Malinta Elementary School – Pinalagad Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the Secretary of Education shall formulate and issue the rules and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
